Guidelines for Local PAANC Scholarship Applicants (PAANC Member Applicants)

Who may apply?

PAANC's scholarship is available to graduating or recently graduated high school students or continuing undergraduate students who have established themselves as active members of the Philippine-American Association of North Carolina (PAANC).

1. An active member of PAANC is defined as a young person whose parent(s) is/are paid member(s) for the last two (2) years and who have participated in one or more activities of PAANC. Verification of PAANC Family membership will be confirmed with the PAANC Membership Committee.
2. Currently a recipient of a high school diploma, who is accepted in an undergraduate program, community, Junior or technical college, entered such program prior to/or on the age of 20 and not over 25.

What is the selection process?

Applicants will be rated according to the following:

Scholastic:	30 points
Volunteerism:	25 points
Essay:	20 points
Other activities, honors, awards:	25 points

Maximum points=100

Recently graduated High School Students will automatically receive 15 point advantage
